




Who is Involved in Testing?

Campus Involvement in SIT1 Testing

- 11 departments and 38 testers for this first cycle
- Campus involvement will increase
 as testing progresses



Phases of Testing

System Integration Testing (SIT)

- Confirms modules within OFC interact correctly with each other
- Verifies modules align with business process requirements



User Acceptance Testing (UAT)


- Confirms that end users can do their jobs using the new technology
- Validates end-to-end business process flow

How Do We Know What to Test?


Business Processes and Workflow (Process: Create Award)



Total Registrations by Division







Who should attend?

Is participation required?


None of these courses are required, however participation is highly encouraged for employees in financial roles. For employees who wish to obtain a certificate, however, completing six of the seven courses is required.
